2023 Attleboro Motor Vehicle Accident & Crash Report



Executive Summary

During 2023, motorists reported 1,759 accidents, which is a mere 0.7% increase from the prior year. This increase for 2023 equates to thirteen additional accidents for the year. While calendar year 2023 was the third consecutive year for a reported increase in vehicle accidents, accidents have yet to return to pre-pandemic levels when motorists were reporting upwards of 2,000 accidents each year. The number of accidents for last year also remained beneath the historic ten-year average between 2013 and 2022 (1809 avg.).


A reduction in accidents was noted in several historical accident hotspot locations across the city in 2023 when compared to the prior year. These hotspot locations include: the uptown area between Fiske Square and the Common (23% decrease); the area around the South Avenue I-95 Interchange (32% decrease); and the Washington Street corridor between May Street and Highland Avenue (6.1% decrease). The only notable hotspot location with a significant increase in accidents for 2023 was the lower Newport Avenue area between the Rhode Island line and the Newport Avenue I-95 Interchange. That area experienced a 23% increase in reported accidents. Additional details can be found on Page 8.


Ninety-one percent of accidents in 2023 involved an impact between two or more vehicles. Similar findings were also noted for the three prior years between 2020 and 2022. Accident trends for 2023 include: accident volume climbing steadily throughout the year, but trending closely to last year's monthly reporting volume; a decline noted again during the summer months; and seventy-five percent of all accident events occurring on a public way. The highest volume of accidents (58%) also appeared to primarily occur between 11AM and 6PM with similar findings in 2021 and 2022. Page 7 lists the most problematic locations / intersections during 2023 with 50% of problem locations situated in South Attleboro.


While pedestrian and deer-related accidents declined last year, accidents involving cyclists increased by three. This is the highest number of reported cyclist accidents over the last five years. OUI-related offenses increased by two additional events for last year. There were no traffic-related fatalities reported during 2023.

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



Vehicle-on-Vehicle Accidents 2023


Vehicle accidents that involved two or more vehicles accounted for 91% of all accidents in 2023, which is a slim increase from the 90% of such accidents reported during 2022. Documented accident reports closely mirrored last year's monthly reporting trends with noticeable dips in reporting during February and August.


Seventy-five percent of all reported vehicle-on-vehicle accidents occurred on a public way last year in 2023. Similar percentages of such accidents were also noted in 2022 (75%) and 2021 (79%).

Fifty-one percent of accidents on a public way occurred at or very close to a road intersection, which is an increase from the 44% reported a year earlier; but similar to the 54% reported two years earlier in 2021. In addition, the distribution of accidents across time remained similar to calendar year 2022 with 58% of all vehicle-on-vehicle impacts occurring during the 2023 year between 11AM and 6PM. Narrowing that percentage down even further, approximately 40% of accident events occurred between 2PM and 6PM.









Bicyclist Accidents 2023

Accidents involving cyclists increased for the second straight year in 2023. It is also the highest number of cyclists struck over the last five years.


Approximately one-third of those accidents occurred along the Washington Street business corridor while another one-third occurred along the Pleasant Street and Park Street business areas.


Cyclists over the last five years have primarily reported accidents during the warmer months of the year. However, during 2023, cyclists reported accident events ten-out-of-twelve months in 2023 instead of six or seven months.


Approximately half of all bicycle-related accidents in 2023 occurred April through June. It should also be noted that more than half of all cyclist accidents in 2023 occurred between 3PM and 5PM.





Pedestrian Strikes 2023


Pedestrian-related accidents declined by one during 2023, when compared to the fifteen such accidents reported to the department during 2022. Such accidents reached their pinnacle during the last decade in 2019 prior to a general decline over the last several years.


Half of these accidents in 2023 occurred in a parking lot, while the other half transpired out on the street. This is a change from the 2022 calendar year when two-out-of-three accidents were reported happening in a parking lot.


Additionally, 95% of pedestrian-related accidents occurred between 4PM and 11PM this past year, with approximately half of those accidents occurring between the 4PM to 6PM timeframe. Reports of struck pedestrians during 2023 were also highest on Wednesdays and Fridays. Those two days of the week also account for the highest number of pedestrian accidents over the last five years.

Deer Strikes 2023


Motor vehicle accidents involving deer declined by two during 2023 when compared to the prior year. The number of these accidents have declined in recent years as there were thirty or more such accidents reported during 2018 and in 2019.


While the threat of deer has declined over the last couple of years, the chance of a strike remains elevated at several locations including parts of West Street, North Main Street and Slater Street.


Approximately half of deer-involved accidents occurred between January and March of 2023. This is a marked change from the fifty percent of incidents reported during November and December in 2022. Sixty percent of deer strikes in 2023 occurred between 6PM and midnight.





OUI Incidents 2023


OUI events increased by two in 2023 when compared to the prior year. The number of OUI incidents have remained stable in recent years and the number of incidents are statistically aligned with reporting over the last ten years.


OUI events occurred in ten out of the twelve months for 2023 and with one-quarter of these OUI reports happening during the month of April. Another one-quarter of OUI events were reported between August and October. Half of all OUI incidents during 2023 occurred between the hours of 10PM and 4AM.


Thirteen out of twenty-eight OUI events were related to a motor vehicle accident, while an additional thirteen OUI charges were the result of a motor vehicle stop. In addition, drivers in 18 out of those 28 OUI events either declined a breath test or were unable to complete one due to their physical condition. The BAC for those persons agreeing to be tested during 2023 ranged between 0.14 and 0.19 percent.


Historic OUI Locations
